The main change to the Photoshop Elements desktop application over the last few versions is the replacement of the "Basic" toolbox for the "Common" toolbox. In order to access some of the more specialized settings in the Photoshop Elements desktop app, you must be using the Classic workspace or the Photography workspace. 2. Opening and Switching Workspaces Photoshop Elements apps are divided into different "workspaces." Each workspace is suited for a specific purpose. As the drive to develop driverless cars becomes a reality, government regulators are trying to determine how self-driving cars should be regulated. Should there be a single national regulatory framework? Or should each state have its own laws? With the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), each regulator has its own agenda, and there is no telling how they will arrive at their final position. I have a strong feeling that the NHTSA and the FMCSA will end up with a framework that regulates self-driving vehicles for the most part, but not exclusively. Currently, self-driving vehicles are currently banned from operating on California highways. Much of California is isolated, with limited access to major highways. Rather than ban self-driving vehicles from California, why not let a few other states attempt to develop self-driving technology? This will give the rest of the country time to figure out the social implications of self-driving vehicles, and the possible technology and security hurdles to adoption. Over the past thirty years, California has been ahead of other states in regulating automobiles, so there is reason to give the process more time. (For those who need a visual, a google search for "California Motor Vehicle" will show you a lot of car designs from the future of today, where cars aren't just for transportation. And as a counterpoint, Ford's plan for the next generation of automobiles can be found here) With so many state-by-state regulations coming into effect, business people will be distracted by state-by-state compliance issues for years to come. If vehicle design is nationalized, a single regulation can be applied to every state and local law is passed to conform to that regulation. While we don't know exactly what the regulation will be, I have a feeling that it will be an 18-year phase-in period where autonomous driving vehicles are allowed and not allowed on the highways of California. The FMCSA has jurisdiction over interstate livery service vehicles, which are vehicles that have a commercial driver's license. Why not let self-driving vehicles operate as livery service vehicles? It will allow passengers to ride in self-driving vehicles as soon as they are ready, without regulatory obstacles to getting started. Even if the FMCSA allows self-driving cars on California's highways, I don't think that it will be
